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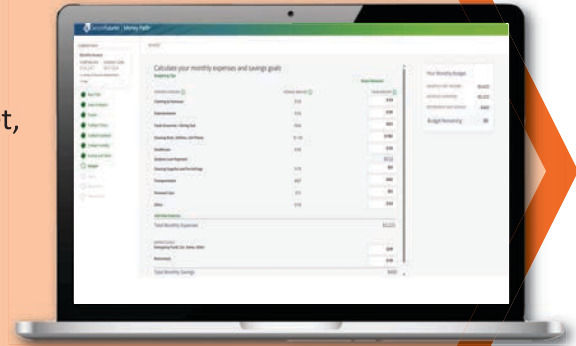

- Supports student portfolio/end-of-semester capstone projects



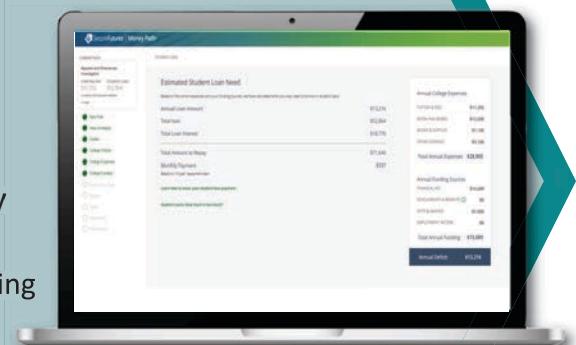
Career/Work-Based Learning Experiences
